Four new French business units join the European Actemium network

- **Actemium - Saint-Laurent (Rhône, France)**, founded in 1995, specialises in the equipment, automobile and manufacturing industries. Valeo, Caterpillar, Flexitech, GE, Danfoss, FagorBrandt, Bosch Rexroth have placed their trust in them.
- **Actemium - Tricastin (Drôme, France)**, specialises in instrumentation and electrical for the nuclear industry. They have been active at AREVA's Tricastin and Marcoule facilities for over 25 years, carrying out engineering, implementation and maintenance works. France's Commission for Atomic Energy (Commissariat à l'Energie Atomique or CEA) is one of their clients.

In ever more complex and competitive industrial markets, this organic growth enables Actemium to put new expertise, skills and resources at our clients' disposal.
